 quire and Appoint that this our Grant shall be enrolled  
 and Registered in the Common Registry of our said Pro-  
 vince of Maryland for the better Confirmation and ma-  
 nifestation thereof for which usual fees are to be paid  
 and the Enrollment and Registry thereof shall be from  
 time to time a sufficient Warrant and discharge to  
 you our Lieutenant and other Officers therefor you  
 suffering performing and doing all the Acts and things  
 hereby required and enjoined you to suffer perform and  
 do as aforesaid Given under our hand and Greater Seal  
 at Arms the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September in the 18<sup>th</sup> Year of our  
 Dominion over the said Province Anno Domini 1649

Whereas Captain William Stone Lieut of  
 this Province by Commission from the right Honorable the  
 Lord Baltimore Lord Proprietary of the same having  
 Occasion to be for some time absent out of this Province  
 do by virtue of and according to the power and Authority  
 to me granted by the said Commission <sup>nominate</sup> elect and appoint  
 Thomas Greene Esq to be his Lordships Lieutenant Genl  
 Chancellor Keeper of the Great Seal Admiral Chief Justice  
 Magistrate and Commander as well by Sea as by Land  
 of this his Lordships Province of Maryland and the Islands  
 to the same belonging during my absence out of this Prov<sup>t</sup>  
 or until his Lordship or his heirs signify his or their plea-  
 sure to the contrary in as large and ample manner as his  
 Lordship hath by the said Commission authorized me to  
 Govern for the present but in case of the said M<sup>r</sup> Greenes  
 Refusal I do hereby nominate elect and appoint M<sup>r</sup>
