A Quictus est Granted to John Han-  
ford Administrator of Thomas  
Weston deceased

Ceillus &c to all the Inhabitants and people in  
our said province of Maryland and to all others whom  
these presents shall Concern Greeting whereas at a Court  
held at Saint Marys within our said province the first  
day of June instant at the request of Mark Theygo Ally  
of W<sup>r</sup> John Hanford Administrator of W<sup>r</sup> Thomas  
Weston deceased and upon view all of the said Adminis-  
trators upon oath and of another Account Given in by  
the said Mark Theygo to William Stone Esq<sup>r</sup> who hath  
an Execution against the said Estate as also of an Oath made  
by the said Mark Theygo concerning the said Estate being  
all upon Record it appearing that the said Administrator  
hath paid 1184<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco beyond Assets and nothing being  
Objected to the contrary albeit publick proclamation was  
then made in Open Court touching the same it was Ordered  
that the said Administrator should have his Quictus est  
upon Consideration whereof these are to will and Require  
you and every of you that from hence forwards you do not  
and forbear any further to sue implead molest or prosecute  
the said John Hanford for or concerning the said Estate  
whereof he is Administrator as aforesaid or any part  
thereof as you will answer the contrary and we do hereby  
Require our Lieutenant chief Governor and Chancellor  
or Keeper of our Great Seal of our said province
