Whereas divers Licenses or warrants have been heretofore granted since the last General Assembly to several Inhabitants of this Province for killing of wild Hogs employing Indians to kill Deer with Guns and some to Foreigners to hunt and kill Deer within this Province which have Occasioned some inconvenience and hath given great Offence to divers of the Inhabitants of this Province as I have been informed I have therefore thought fit and do hereby Revoke annul and make void all Licenses or Warrants before mentioned
