At the request of Mr. Thomas Hatton these are in the names of the Peeres of the Tibourus of England by Authority of Parliament to Authorise Sir Mich^l Gwyther or any other Inhabitant of this Province whom the said Mr. Hatton shall appoint and direct for that purpose to levy by execution in the usual manner all or any such fees as were due to him the said Mr. Hatton as Secretary here at any time before the 29th day of March last and yet unpaid from any person or persons within this Province upon the Body or Goods of every or any of them respectively and for so doing this shall be his or their warrant Given at Saint Marys this 22^d day April 1652
