Sheweth

That whereas formerly ther hath been by the
Eastern Shoo Indians one mulched and now of late one
all of them inhabitants of this Island and Subjects of this Province a Dwelling House
Shott another hill and stroy near whis own house and
much Goods Burned as is conceived by Indians to say
Nothing of the continual Trade of killing of Hogs they are so
Imboldned these mathes being past by and being so well
furnished with Gun powder and Shot that they come about
our houses night and day so that lawes and disturbances
are Occasioned weekly nay daily so that some are so dreading
and affrighted they have left their plantation and many
are resolved to desert the Island which tends to our weakening
and the encouragement of those heathens to make a prey of
those that shall be left and so to make themselves by degrees
more strong to proceed and go on in their minches designed
we are also informed that the Eastern Shoo Indians have great
store of Powder and Shot and many guns notably in which
they formerly bought and have taken in Captain Gugens his
which but they have long since taken a Dutch Sloop with
