

at Kent hereafter mentioned and for twenty days after  
 with one Gun well fixed one pound half pound and six  
 pounds of Shot and all other fitting and necessary pro-  
 visions Arms and Ammunition for this service from which  
 Charge no Inhabitants of this Province Council or others  
 not pressed as aforesaid is to be exempted and it is further  
 Ordered that all and every the forces so to be raised as aforesaid  
 in Saint Marys County Charles County and Patuxent River  
 on the Northside thereof shall meet together at Mutter Service  
 upon the said Patuxent River near to the house late of Tho<sup>s</sup>  
 Hair there upon the twentieth day of December next toge-  
 ther with such Boats or other Vessels as shall be pressed or other-  
 wise provided for the transportation as aforesaid every of the  
 Soldiers to be fitted with Victuals Arms and Ammunition  
 and other necessary Provisions for this Service as aforesaid where  
 the Governor is desired to appoint some able person or Com-  
 mander to take a view of them as also how they are Accom-  
 modated in every particular for the service and under whose  
 Conduct and Command they may with all convenient speed  
 be transported with such view taken as aforesaid unto the  
 Isle of Kent to the General Rendezvous there upon the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
 of the said month of December next and it is further also  
 Ordered that all and every the persons and Soldiers so to be  
 pressed and so furnished with Arms Ammunition and  
 Victuals and all other necessary provisions for the Service  
 aforesaid together with all Boats and other Vessels appointed  
 for this Service as aforesaid shall and are hereby appointed  
 God permitting them to meet together at the said General  
 Rendezvous upon the said Island of Kent upon the said  
 thirtieth day of December <sup>next</sup> there to be disposed of and Employed  
 for this Service under the Conduct and Command of Captain  
 William Fuller of which . . . . .
