The Governor with the advice of the Council hath made
choice of his command in this present march and
expedition or under the command of his Lieutenant General to be by
him chosen and appointed for their employment and for
the better convenience of fixing of Guns as occasion shall
serve upon this march it is ordered that William Thompson
servant to John Dandy of Saint Marys County be
granted for one of the seven men in the County and
that such tools as are necessary for his fixing of Guns be
granted or otherwise provided from John Dandy for the
time of his service and it is further ordered that for all
such Indian prisoners that shall happen to be taken
and brought in when this march is ended they shall be
divided according to their value upon a General Division
throughout the Province amongst every mess that are
at the charge of setting forth the seventh herein before men-
tioned unless the Provincial Court shall think fit to dis-
pose of any of them otherwise and that as to other pur-
chase or plunder either in Com or otherwise from the said
Indian Enemy during this intended march it is to go
upon a general division among the Commanders and Sol-
diers employed in the service as the Provincial Court shall
direct and think fit special regard being to be had thereon
of those that shall best demean themselves in the service
and lastly the Governor is hereby desired by his Commission
and Warrant to hasten and further this intended March
with all possible speed and hury to give what further direc-
tion and limitation he shall think fitting for the better
carrying on and prosecution of this expedition.
