timore Lord Proprietor of this Province wch the Measure
of the State of Maryland by further known it is therefore Ordaine
ed by the aforesaid Commissiones with the advice and
consent of the Council and others the Inhabitants that
Captain William Stoney be the Governor and Mr Tho
Mason Robert Brookes Esq Captain John Price Mr Job
Chandler Col Francis Threlley and Mr Richard Preston
be of the Council for this Province who are to Govern under
and direct the aforesaid three of small matters according to
the former power and the Order or proclamation aforesaid
and to hold Courts for the better administration of Just
ice as often as they shall think fit until further Orders
of Parliament therein and in the mean tyme all persons
whatsoeuer are required and commanded to take Notice
hereof and to conform thereto accordingly and since
the Government is so settled as is knowable by the good
liking of the Inhabitants it is conceived for that and
several other Reasons that there is no absolute necessity
of a General Assembly at present given under our hands
at Saint Marys the 28th day of June 1652
