them a Gun well fixed one pound and an half of powder  
and six pounds of shot and victuals for twenty days  
after the said General day of Rendezvous and with all  
other necessary Arms Ammunition and provision according  
to the said Order which Arms Ammunition and provision  
is to be found and provided by you at the charge of every of  
the other six <sup>out</sup> of whom the said seventh man is to be prepared  
as a servant and which Arms Ammunition and provision  
you may by occasion be levy or press accordingly and the  
said men so pressed and accommodated as aforesaid are  
then and there to attend the command of Captain W<sup>m</sup>  
Fuller their said Captain General or Commander in chief  
for this expedition to all intents and purposes in the aforesaid  
Order and in his the said Captain Generals Commission  
contained so far as it doth or may concern them or any of  
them and this upon the strictest penalty in cases of this  
nature provided hereof fail not at your peril Given at
