 of the 25<sup>th</sup> day of this present month of November sent herewith  
 to Captain William Fuller the said Captain General or Command  
 de in chief in the said Order named which men so pressed are  
 to be at the General Rendezvous upon the said Island of Kent  
 the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December next with each of them a Gun well  
 fixed one pound and a half of powder and six pound of Shot  
 and Victuals for twenty days after the said day of General  
 Rendezvous and with all other necessary Arms ammunition and  
 Provision according to the said Order which arms ammuni  
 tion and provision is to be found and provided by or at the  
 Charge of every of the other six out of whom the said seventh  
 man is to be pressed as aforesaid and which arms ammunition  
 and provision you may if Occasion belevy you press accordingly  
 and the said men so pressed and accommodated as aforesaid  
 are then and there to attend the Commands of the said Captain  
 William Fuller to all intents and purposes in the foresaid Order  
 and in his the said Captain General's Commission contained so  
 far as it doth or may Concern them or any of them and this  
 upon the strictest penalty in cases of this nature provided  
 hereof fail you not at your self given at Saint Marys this  
 29 day of November 1652
