

Commander, of Annamundell County and Captain Robert
 Vaughan, of the Isle of Kent County within this Province
 dated 29th July 1650 I thereby authorized them for the
 case of the Inhabitants of those remote Counties to grant
 warrants for Land according to his Lordships Conditions
 in their severall Counties aforesaid with further directions
 in the said Commissions contained and whereas I am
 given to understand that not only the transmitting
 of such warrants demands and Assignments into the
 Secretarys Office here as by the said Commissions is di-
 rected is somewhat neglected but also the due return of
 the Certificates of Survey thereupon to the Great prejudice
 not only of his Lordship in his Rents due upon such Sur-
 veys but also to the great Wrong and abuse of the said Se-
 cretarys Office and likely in short time to produce much
 Confusion and inconvenience for prevention whereof these
 are in the names of the Kings of the Liberties of England
 by Authority of Parliament and as Governour here under
 his said Lordship to declare the said Commissions or any
 other for that purpose by me granted to the said Captain
 Robert Vaughan and Mr Edward Lloyd as aforesaid to
 be void and null and that no warrant or warrants for
 Land be thereupon granted by them or either of them after
 the last of this present month of December further hereby
 willing and requiring as well the said Captain Vaughan
 and Mr Lloyd as also his Lordships Surveyor General that
 they the said Captain Vaughan and Mr Lloyd do cause
 transcripts of all such Demands or titles of Land Assignments
 and warrants within their severall Counties as are not
 yet transmitted into the Secretarys Office to be speedily trans-
 mitted thither there to be entered and that the said Surveyor
 General make speedy return into the Secretarys Office
