According to the directions and appointment of the Right honorable Lord Baltimore Lord Proprietary of this Province in his Lordships declaration under his Lordships hand and Seal of the 6<sup>th</sup> of August last I have thought fit and do hereby allow unto his Lordships Attorney General Mr Thomas Hallon for his pains in the execution of that Office this present year 1650 one thousand pounds of Tobacco and Cash or the value thereof out of his Lordships Rents and Revenues here as also the same quantity of Tobacco and Cash or value yearly during his the said Mr Hallons continuance of that employment or that his Lordships pleasure be further herein signified to the contrary and published in this Province Given at St Marcs this 10<sup>th</sup> day of January Anno Domini 1650
