

A proclamation was here made in open Court was then
 Ordered that the said Walter Beane and Walter flakes should
 have their Quittus est upon Consideration whereof there are
 to will and require you and every of you that from hence for-
 wards you do sit and forbear to sue implead or prosecute
 against the said Walter Beane or Walter flakes for or concerning
 the said Estate whereof they are Administrators as aforesaid
 or any part thereof as you will Answer the contrary and we
 do hereby require our Lieutenant chief Governor Chancellor
 or Keeper of our Great Seal of our said Province for the time
 being and all and every our Councillors Commanders and
 Commissioners and all other Justices Judges and Magis-
 trates within our said Province by us appointed & autho-
 rized and to be from time to time by us our heirs hereafter
 appointed and Authorized for matters of Judicature that
 they and every of them be careful from time to time as Oc-
 casion shall require to see our will and pleasure herein be-
 fore declared to be duly Observed and performed according
 to Justice and that in case the said Walter Beane and Wal-
 ter flakes or either of them shall happen at any time here-
 after to be sued impleaded or prosecuted in any of our Courts
 of Justice in our said Province contrary to our true intent
 and meaning herein before signified that they and every
 of them then present in Court should admit and allow of
 this Quittus est on the Record thereof for a lawful and sufficient
 plea in Barr to all and every such suit Action or demand
 in writs whereof we have caused our Secretary of our said
 Province of Maryland to publish the same under our Great
 Seal of our said Province Given at Saint Marys this 21 day
 of June Anno Dni 1654
