Whereas the payment of his Lordships Rents  
hath been of late years very much slighted and neglected  
by divers of the Inhabitants of this County of Saint Ma-  
ry to the Great dishonour of his Lordship and the Gov<sup>t</sup>  
here established under him yet no strict or rigorous  
Course hath been hitherto taken since my Arrival here  
as Governour to compell the payment thereof as in Jus-  
tice the weight in hopes that mild and favourable dea-  
lings would have produced better effects then it seems  
it hath therefore to Give notice to all and every  
the Inhabitants of Saint Marys County and all others  
who hold any Land of his Lordship within this pro-  
vince for which by their Grants there Rents are made
