Whereas at a Court held at Saint Marys the 26th day of September last I did adjourn the then next General Provincial Court formerly appointed to be held the twentieth day of October last till the first day of December next now these are in the names of the Keepers of the Liberties of Engl^d by Authority of Parliament and as Lieut^g General and Gov^r of this Province under the right Honble the Lord Baltimore Lord Proprietary thereof to Give notice to the Inhabitants of this Province and others whom it may concern that forasmuch as no necessity appears of holding a General Court so soon no English Shipping being yet arriv'd here and that for divers reasons relating to the publick welfare it were requisite if please God it may so happen that we received some directions out of England touching the Government here before a General Court I have thought fit therefore and do hereby adjourn the ^{General} next Provincial Court from the first of December next aforesaid till the tenth day of January next and all Warrants summons and other proce^ss and references formerly made out and appointed either for the 20th of October or the first of December aforesaid are hereby Reinforced and to stand good in all respects for and until the said Court to be held the tenth of January next herein before appointed Given at Saint Marys this 7th day of November Anno Dni 1653
