the said Order of Reference (as it is very creditably
Reported) Master Surveyor Nicholas Keetinge Master
Ruth and others have of late in a bold contemptuous
and unmerciful manner gotten up killed and dis-
posed of to their own use otherwise a great number of
well unmarked and other little to his Lordships Great
Wrong and abuse and contempt of the Government
he is settled under him for which the said Attorney gen-
eral doth in convenient time to call them to a strict Acco-
unt for the better prevention of the like insolencies for
the future and to put ^{speedy} stop to the said contemptuous
and unmerciful proceedings these are in the names
