thority here under his Lordship they be Authorised for so
doing as they will answer the contrary at their peril Given

A Proclamation

According to the special direction & ap-
pointment of the right Honourable Charles Lord
Baron of Baltimore Lord Proprietor of this Province of
Maryland in that behalf made in the said Lord pro-
prietors name to give notice and declare to all and every
the Inhabitants of this Province and others whom it doth
or may concern that whereas his said Lordship understandeth
divers persons inhabiting within this Province have not
seed out their patents in due time for the Land which they
claim to be due unto them who have taken the Oath of
Fidelity as they ought to have done according to his Lordships
Conditions of plantation whereby they claim such Land
Yet his Lordship out of his good affection to them is not
willing to take such Advantage as he justly might therupon
against them without giving them first fair warning
by this proclamation whereof wherein but is contained
