 A Proclamation

Whereas upon the sixth day of this present month of May
 upon the Occasion and Commemoration of the then publick
 or proclaiming of his Highness the Lord Protector I did pub-
 licly declare that I thought fit to Grant a General pardon
 of all Offences committed within this Province since the
 last General pardon with such exceptions and in such man-
 ner as should be made apparent at the publication thereof
 this Court in pursuance whereof these are in the Lord Proprie-
 tarys name to declare and publish that I do in Commemo-
 ration of the Solemnity before mentioned pardon and Re-
 mit all pains forfeitures and penalties which any person
 or persons shall or may incur or sustain for or by reason of
 any Crime misdemeanor or Offence committed within this
 Province against any the Laws Ordinances or Orders for
 the Government thereof since the last General pardon here
 published to this present day except for Murder or Treason
 and except also all forfeitures and penalties for any Crime
 or Offence at any time heretofore in any Court within this
 Province adjudged to be paid to the Lord Proprietary &
