There were certain orders established by general  
 consent, to be observed during ye assembly. viz

Orders.

First, ye Lieutenant shall be President of ye Assembly, shall  
 appoint and direct all things that concern forme and decency to be  
 observed in ye house, and shall command ye observance thereof as he  
 shall see cause, upon paine of imprisonment or fine as ye house shall adudge.

Item, no man shall be allowed to speak to any matter, till he have  
 been called on by the house.
