in ye county of S<sup>t</sup>. maries, on Wednesday ye 31. of  
January 1637. upon view of ye body of our John  
Briant, late of mattsawinent planter deceased, you and  
your living dead below given,

to ye number of twelve jurors, present and agreed  
to require you to say what you know of it truly.

you say you were at ye aforesaid John Briant by ye fall of a tree  
had it blown down upon; and got two felling of it & laid one on your  
left side; & so yet by means of ye fall of ye said tree you give  
ye said John Briant cause by ye death. And further ye wood  
aforesaid when you say that ye part was noted to ye death  
of ye said John Briant; & therefore find ye said tree unfeild to ye  
said Proprietor.

The examination of John Edlow of mattsawinent  
planter, taken by witness of an old acquaintance  
by ye Coroner aforesaid; on ye day aforesaid.

Ye ye said John Edlow day say you it was, when you say Examinate and ye  
said John Briant were felling of a tree in your plantation; and  
being likely to fall, ye Examinate called to ye said John Briant, and said,  
take care of your self, for the tree is falling; at w<sup>t</sup>. wood the said tree  
wood bark from ye tree fell on ye ground, & ye tree falling fell upon a  
tree not farre off; and upon body of the tree w<sup>t</sup>. tree fell downe, rebounded to  
said John Briant, & killed him, & yet it hit John Briant so he did not fall to

the apparent planter being likewise knowne, but yet he did not hit him w<sup>t</sup>.
