And if you shall not so do: you will and grant for yourselfe or your heirs executors and administrators that the said twelve hundred fiftie and two pound of tobacco be levied upon the lands goods & chattels of you the said Robert Peilpott and John Langford whereof you shall be found.  
This recognisance was executed by consent of the Recognisance.

And if you shall not so do: you will and grant for yourselfe or your heirs executors and administrators that the said 391. lb of tobacco & value be levied upon the lands goods & chattels of the said Edmund Parry whereof you shall be found.
