if ym like it rale; if not, & chaffre it. & afterward ym self did arange
of it, & Cornewall^{est} goe nowtherd ymself not bound to make it good.

and upon the debating of his cause, and getting general opinion of the Court & the
jury ~~the~~ ^{the} judge determined, Roger may desired that Robt. Mignot told
him that Mr. Letham was wounded by ~~from~~ underlay, and Robt. Mignot desired that
Mr. Letham was never wounded to his knowledge, and that the master told Roger may
any thing. And the judge determined, that it was not wounded by his fault
nor mistake, & so saying took his self & went & sat at his own will; & said
not another word to def.

At Day nine before us Leonard Calvert Esq; Lieutenant grall of his Province
Robert nicholls and John Middle of St maries hundred planters and artificers
lidge yowdles imbrled unto Captainne Snowe y^e full summe of two hundred
and sixty punds of good maturable tobacco to be paid unto said Captainne
Snowe or his assignt for 16th payll of October next if Robert nicholls or
otherwise at y^e first payll of paying tobacco. And if ye shall not so do for
so will and want for yowdles y^e punds exequitor aduocator and assignt
at y^e said summe of tobacco shall be leturd vpon y^e last goods & gattes of y^e gen
re said Robert nicholls and John Middle wch are to be payed unto him selfe
one punds and paylls.
