william Brumley and will write followynge in 1638 next

The last will and testamet of william Brumley made in  
Augusta Carolina at St. maries in maryland anno domini 1638.

In the name of God Amen. I will & desire goodly & ioy in myt life and  
after myt death wchre compulsion or constraint doe freely make & dispense of my estate  
and goods in this manner following. Desirous to please Almighty God my gibber of all good things  
and to take away for after time all carenes of my self about myt deeth wchre I leave myt body and  
my better and wchre more quicke to attan to other eygge and more important matter of my soul  
for myt eternitie þt I rochly to enter into; first of myt body, my soul into myt hand of my Creator  
þking in his preciuos blood of my Lord and redemeour Jesu Christ yet my will bring you into his  
glory. Secondly of myt body, my body unto god care from whence it was taken, willingly and  
ring the deale eygge of myt swete Jesu Christ my Lord and of all þt Saint is a  
sacrifice of. Testification þt me friends, on wchre God gave me myt bren. And hereof þt profess  
eth I am a member of þt Calvynist Romane church out of wchre it is no salvation. Thirdly  
of myt temporall goods I dispense in this manner following. In first place of ghes and bequale  
unto my loving wife in þt chace & family full and entierly all and other vassell and want  
of my goods notable or immovable and whatsoever I haue or at my deat þt ghes or þt shall  
þt any way mind or due unto me; fourmouthe only eygge of wchre I leave for my  
good of my soule desirous only to pray for my friends. Secondly of appoint and make  
my þttest and chace Brumley my loving wife alone my full and absolute Exequator þt  
þt in my last will and testamet, to exerce take and ordene wchre any way doth may or shall  
appertene to me now or hereafter, declaring for her indemnity and quiet possession wchre  
of wchre nothing. In witness whereof I putt to þt my hand and þtale þt in þt daye  
anno domini 1638.
