 mard of Duties, cloes, two yards of rucke & a litle more; fiftene paire of  
 ruff stockings, one pair of some beards, twelve combs, fift goods,  
 twelve carps, looking glasses to the value of 10<sup>l</sup> ~~of the said goods~~ and etc to the  
 value of 40<sup>l</sup> Indian: And the said Henry Fleet doth acknowledge himselfe  
 to owe unto the Lord Proprietor one hundred fiftie and five pound of tobacco  
 And for the length of the said truck if it shall be expended for labor, or some  
 other use or beyond license: and for such part thereof as shall not be wanted for  
 season or some further use if licensed, it is to be disposed to the said Henry Fleet  
 according to the proportion it part in the value of the truck: and further the said  
 Henry Fleet doth promise himselfe to pay to the Lord Proprietor the full  
 value of all the said goods or some (further use is licensed for)  
 w<sup>ch</sup> he shall use any Indian w<sup>ch</sup> or for the said truck or any part thereof. Pro-  
 vided that if it shall be adjudged at the Court that the said Henry Fleet  
 shall not be made by virtue of any former license without paying the length,  
 and the said license shall be wholly void: and the said Henry Fleet is  
 to be accountable to the common stock for what he shall buy or  
 sell in the said trade ~~of the said goods~~. In witness whereof the said  
 Henry Fleet hath subscribed his hand the 20<sup>th</sup> Febr: 1637.

 the said five hundred weight of tobacco and ruff; and the said five barrels  
 of round round to be levied upon the land goods w<sup>ch</sup> shall be of him the said  
 Henry Fleet notwithstanding the said round.
