agreed between Capt. Robt. Smith, and Capt. George Evelyn, that the said Robt. Smith is to lett unto the said George Evelyn five of his servants (whereof Evelyn for 10. working daies next ensuing, for the rate of 10^l. of tobacco for every servant, to be paid on the 10th of November next, and if the said George Evelyn shall be willing to employ you after the expiring of the said ten daies, for ten daies longer or vnder, it is then to pay for you after the said rate.

9th April 1630.

12th day it is agreed between Capt. George Evelyn on the one part, and Phillip Woff, William Williamson, and John Cooper on the other part, that the said Phillip Woff, William Williamson and John Cooper, are put free to work for themselves & to their own account from the day of the date hereof until the day next ensuing, and you are to returne againe to the service of the said George Evelyn or to be assigned according to their Indenture, and in consideration hereof the said Phillip Woff, William Williamson, and John Cooper, are during the next year to find themselves with clothing, Diett & all necessaries, and doe quitt their wages otherwise due unto you by their Indenture, and doe renounce and bind themselves and day of them by themselves & bind themselves absolutely to pay unto the said George Evelyn or to his assignee, your hundred weight of tobacco good & merchantable on the 10th of November next, that is one hundred weight apiece for each of you.
