It was ordered by the Court that Richard Garnett should pay all residue of
John Thriant's estate remaining in his hands or to be received for, unto the Thomas
Cotton toward satisfaction of his debt, reserving only 20th of tobacco in
his hands, or to be received, to defend himself in law against other creditors.

May 7th 1638.

Capt. George Bodin, of the said, solemnly and undertakenly before us,
to pay and satisfie unto John Dandie, all his arrears of wages as shall
in Court admitted to be due unto him; and further to warrant his
grant unto him of our grants freedom, for his quiet enjoying and pos-
sioning of it against all claimers by him or under the said George
Bodin, or his Heirs, or assigns, or company. And John Langer
