was said, that enquiring after the boat that was said to be cast away on the  
Eastern Point, he learned that it was the boat of one Rowland Williams  
of Dorchester; & that he was killed by the Indians of those parts; and that  
the wife was in the boat with him; & he was told by the young King of  
Wissamouset that it was the wigwam, or the wigwam, or the wigwam;  
& that the King of Wapamut was within 6 miles of the place where it was  
done; & that within 2 or 3 days after the slaughter, the said King  
away the boat to Wapamut.
