Memorandum that the day and before me Captain Henry Fleete, and
 acknowledged himselfe to owe unto the Lord Proprietor one hundred
 pound weight of good beaver to be paid unto the Receiver of the said Lord
 Proprietor ~~at~~ ^{at} ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~same~~ ^{same} demand. And if he shall not so doo
 upon the will of the grantors for himselfe, his exors, executors and administrators
 that the said summe of beaver be levied upon the lands goods & chattels
 of him the said Henry Fleete or his exors or assigns.

The condition of the Resignation is that if the Resignation of Henry
 Fleete, shall not be himselfe or his factor or procuree, willy
 any Indians within the Province of the Province, nor shall transport
 any vessel or persons any part of the Province to trade willy any Indians
 or the contrary side of the Province, nor shall he or his factor or procuree
 or any other person obtaine or get out of the Province for any thing being
 or else to stand in full payment.
