Suff^o. four hundred pounds sterling; Now y^e Depositions say that the said debt of four hundred pounds, was (after y^e contracting thereof) assigned and made over unto Thomas Cornewall of S^t. Maries Ely who gave unto y^e said John Smith, full and well satisfaction hereof.
