 5th of September 1634. by m^r Secretary.

the deponent saith that on the 10th of April last being with Capt. Robert
 window in the house, the deponent heard the said Robert window & free and
~~discharge~~ Edward Parker and William Naufin from all obligation of
 service to him, declaring that he had received from James of Devon
 Parker certain goods in England for which he was obliged by promise to
 free the said Edward from the ordinary conditions of apprenticeship at his
 arrival in the country. And further said William Naufin he declar-
 ed that he brought him not over as a servant, but to charge him with
 some, and to hold him up at Poole. Tho: Hayden
