 making any will or disposition of his goods ^{as affirmed}, or at least at is
 known or may be produced; we willing to provide freely for the settling and
 disposing of his said goods, do hereby ^{we will or appoint} commit unto you the Administration
 thereof to be proved in our Court, ^{by our Secretary of our said Province} for a year from the day of the date
 hereof, ^{and} until you shall bring in ^{the} Account of the Administration
 upon demand of our Secretary within and after a reasonable time ^{for}
 making of the same, ^{and} commit unto you the Administration of all his right goods and
 chattels ^{which were of him} belonging to the said Brogus at the time of his said
 decease, either upon the main or within ^{the} Province ^{charging you}
 by virtue of your oath made unto us in this behalf ^{as affirmed} that you make and exhibit
 to our Secretary ^{and} a true and correct appraisement to be made of all his
 said goods & chattels ^{which were} ^{of him} ^{at the} ^{time of} ^{his} ^{decease}
 return to us ^{for} ^{our} ^{purpose}; and that you will make a true & exact Inventory
 of all his said right goods & chattels, to be made by the said Secretary
 and by the appraisement of his goods ^{and} ^{chattels} you will exhibit & deliver to the said Secretary
 within ^{the} month after the date hereof ^{at} ^{the} ^{place} ^{where} ^{you} ^{shall} ^{be} ^{given}
 by the said Secretary; and that you will well & truly pay all the debts of the
 said ^{deceased} Brogus due or demanded within the Province; and that you will
 make & exhibit to the said Secretary a faithful and true Account of the said
 Administration; upon your oaths sworn unto called by the said Secretary. Given

Memorandum that the day ~~same~~ before me Marmaduke Snow gent
 and ~~Gilbert Brent~~, gent ~~and~~ and acknowledge themselves to owe
 unto the Lord Proprietaries, twenty thousand weight of tobacco &c.

The condition of this Recognisance is that if the said Marmaduke
 Snow shall well & truly perform the condition hereof
 he is charged in a Commission of Administration bearing date the day
 of this date Brogus Jupinian Snow deceased, upon a will or copy
 of the said Jupinian will by him or by you proved before the Secretary,
 for all his debts goods & chattels of the said Jupinian will ^{and} ^{chattels}
 in his said Administration at that time; that the said Recognisance
 is to be void or else to stand in full force. And a further condition
 of this Recognisance is that the goods of the said Jupinian be returned
 by the said Marmaduke Snow unto the Administration; or else the said Recognisance to be void.
