Corollary to the report by the Court of Admiralty bearing date the 1st of March 1639
 In August 1638 the Court did order & appoint Capt. Tho: Cornewallt Esq: and
 one of the Council of the Province of Maryland to be Administrators of the goods &
 of debts within the said Province in the name of the said Court of Admiralty
 who were appointed at the time of the death of the said Cornewallt as well by the Court
 as by the said Administrators to see that a full & perfect inventory of
 all the said goods and debts, to be rendered a full & perfect account thereof
 in the Court of Admiralty as your Honors called, or otherwise, should be forth; and
 that the said Court of Admiralty should accordingly make an inventory
 of the said goods & debts, which was done & delivered to the Secretary on the 14th of August
 following amounting to the value of 24^l. 13^s. 4^d. & being valued at by two discreet
 men sworn by the Secretary to see that the said goods were of the value & appraised
 and afterward set it to the said Court of Admiralty following brought in
 the account of the said Secretary, of the value of the said goods & debts of
 the said Cornewallt in full and exact payment of the debt of the said Cornewallt
 & set to the value of 5^l. 6^s. 1^d. and the residue remaining in the said
 goods & debts delivered to the said Secretary, and the said Secretary to
 be delivered to the said Admiralty. In witness whereof we as well appro-
 ving of the said inventory & well for the name of the said Court of Admiralty
 do hereby approve of the said account, & declare that the said Cornewallt
 hath performed do acquit & discharge the said Cornewallt of
 of all further account & question touching the said Admiralty; witness
 the 4th of May 1639.
