Memorandum 11th in consideration of 200 pound sum of money...
to Thomas Franklin & Walter Marill, of Dorset, 21: one, county, and more over unto us, here
his assigns, all my crops of tobacco now being at St. Georges to give and to hold unto
you, for my use, until the feast of Christmas next, in case before that time I had not
paid unto the said Mr. Lowger or his assigns the full sum of 200 pound of good
lawful tobacco & wright at some place in St. Georges river, and if I had not, to do you to give and
to give unto his assigns such other sums as shall be due unto him.

For the security of the amount of 100 pound owing to me Secretary, of good money or banknote to you
all my interest in our bounded row, and our black piece, w^{ch} I bought of Christopher of Virg:
to wit if the said debt be not satisfied or paid before Christmas next you are to give unto the
row, & piece as from the day at the rate of our England w^{ch} of 100. And if you die afore the
time, the year is to be mine, you may demand of me the said security in place of what shall be due. And if
the said debt be satisfied or paid afore the said time you are to give unto the said row from the day
to be to my use, as if the deed had not been.

Copie of a Recognizance 14 August 1642.

Amounted the day w^{ch} Mr. Lowger, and I remaine debtor to you twelve hundred and fifty
of tobacco & wright. For security whereof I do hereby make over to you all my crops of
tobacco now being upon the ground, to the use of the said Mr. Lowger until the said debt be
& afterwards to my use. And upon the payment of twelve hundred, Mr. Lowger promises
to forgive the said fifty.

Copie of a deed devised by Jo. Hollis to be entered upon record; 31. Octob 1642.

Know all men by these presents that I
doe hereby acknowledge my selfe to owe to an indebted unto you
the full sum of one thousand pounds of good merchantable lawfull tobacco
proof of the said debt my executors & assigns will all...
I doe bind and make over the foresaid crops unto John Hollis of the said...
unto his executors & assigns, & doe give you the said John Hollis full...
afore said; w^{ch} I doe both my hand the 27th day of Octob 1642
