General.

Carries Land and Proprietary of his plantation and countries of Maryland and all
the parts of America, Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To all and singular persons
to whom it shall be given, bearing Crossing. Know ye that we for better for worse
Persons vs presents sending, etc. rebuke and determine, and by these parts do
declare that we do hereby rebuke and rebuke determine all persons Commission
granted unto dear Brother Leonard Calvert Esq; or to any other person
whatsoever, for or concerning the government of the said Province of Maryland, and
all power & authority by us reserved granted unto you or to any officer of the Council
or to any other person whatsoever in the said Commission or any of them
and we do hereby likewise disapprove all & every of the & parts whatsoever from our
Council, and to be of the Council within the said Province of Maryland, w^t grant
ever been of the Council before.

Moreover also considering the well knowing that by reason of our
continuall peace & safety without just good government to be ordained and established
as well for the suppressing of all rebellions and disorders, as for the punishment of the law
and disorderly persons among us, and calling to mind the justfull and lawable arbitrie
done by the said dear Brother Leonard Calvert Esq; aforesaid in the adventure of the
warre in the first, second & third year of the Colony within the said Province of Maryland
as in the ordering & advancing of the same by his personal estimation within the said
& said Province, wherein hee manifested to the satisfaction of us, his selfe and of our
colonie people, his wisdom, fidelity, industry & other vertutes as to make him capable
wherof hee by us intended to be reported in him; gave us in writing
couphited ordained authorized established & by these parts do nominate ordaine and
rule authority & establish the said Leonard Calvert in the aforesaid place and office
of Lieutenant General, Admirall, Captaine & Commander aforesaid by him as by law
of the said Province of Maryland & the Islands to the same belonging. And we
do by these parts grant unto him his office commandant & al places authority above
in all matters of warre by him and law to execute & minister to the same to
the resistance of the enemy, or suppression of mutiny & insubordination, as the said Lieut
Gen^t might neede command for the preparation of the said Province, and to do all
thinges as doe belongeth or appertaineth to the office of a General, Admirall, Captaine
Commander in as large & ample maner to all intent & purpose, as we do our
pleasure might doe if we were personally present by force or virtue of the said parts to be
granted by the Sovereign Lord King Charles under the great Seal of England beth
date at westm^t 15th day of June in 1638 in the year of our Lord reigned.
We give and appointe & minister to the same will, power & as ample power and authority
as we or weours were personally present might doe or execute by force or
virtue of these parts aforesaid, until we shall signify otherwise to the contrary.

And we do hereby further ordaine & command all persons, al places
persons of our Council within the said Province of Maryland, all Captains Officers
and soldiers aforesaid by him as by law where it doth, or may concern, all other
residents Baileys Marqualls & all other inhabitants of the said Province of Maryland
of what quality & condition soever they be & every of them do as knowledge
the said Leonard Calvert in the quality of Lieut General Admirall Captaine
& Commander over all the forces of the Province of Maryland and the Islands & indeed
of the same, and doo execute respect thereto him as they ought to doe upon paine
that, & punishment to be inflicted upon them & every of them if they do a thinge contreyng as
we do or weours were personally present might doe or execute by force or virtue of
these parts aforesaid, until we shall signify otherwise to the contrary
ignorance we do command these parts Commission & Ordinance to be proclaymed & published
in the said Province at all places aforesaid to proclayme & publish our said Lieut General
Commanding him the said Lieutenant to proceed with al his power & authority, & indepent
of his force in his riot & rebuke manner as we do, & he might doe by force or virtue of
the said parts, & whose were personally present and byt without favour to command
