from time to time in such cases to nominate elect & appoint such an able person  
living & residing within the said Province of Maryland as you in your discretion shall  
judge of & you shall be the said Lieutenant, Council, Admirall, Captain  
Magistrate & Comander as well by sea as by land of the said Province of Maryland and of  
the said Islands to you same belonging, and in as large & ample manner as was able by  
the said authority given to said Lieutenant to govern for the said Province. And in case  
said Lieutenant shall happen to die or be absent out of the said Province of Maryland, and shall  
fail to make choice of nominate & appoint some person to be the said Lieutenant, Council,  
Admirall, Captain, Magistrate and Comander of the said Province of Maryland  
as well by sea as by land, we do hereby give & grant unto the said Council, Admirall,  
or the greater part of you full power & authority from time to time in every such case  
to nominate elect & appoint such an able person within the said Province of Maryland  
as you or the greater part of you shall make choice of and you shall be the said Lieutenant,  
Council, Admirall, Captain, Magistrate & Comander as well by sea as by land of the said  
Province of Maryland and of the said Islands to you same belonging. We give & grant  
unto you & said Lieutenant full power & authority to be given & appointed in any  
case as aforesaid we do hereby declare that the said Lieutenant, Council, Admirall,  
Captain & Comander of the said Province of Maryland during the absence of the said  
or until we or our heirs shall signify our pleasure to the contrary. To wit the  
Council, Admirall, Captain, Magistrate & Comander to be elected  
nominated & appointed as aforesaid we do hereby give & grant unto the said
