 mind the said Commission, to be & execute & execute Commissioners and Commissioners
 for conservation of the peace within the said Province of Maryland, and do hereby
 grant unto you & every of you (in respect any breach of peace, full power within you
 or any or either of your wives, or in respect you shall be informed of any breach of
 peace, full power & authority to arrest or call before you by your warrant to be directed
 by the said Justice Consistors or your Officers of Counties towns & villages & other
 places within the said Province of Maryland all & every your offenders & offenders agt
 the peace, and if you shall be unable to bind over your offender or offenders with a good surety
 or sureties to appear before the Lieutenant Governour and the Council of the said Province
 at the same, & in the meantime time to keep your offender or offenders in good
 custody till they shall require. And in default of such sureties or sureties to be
 or offenders committed unto you, to commit your offender or offenders to the common
 gaol or next prison within the said Province as to you shall seeme fitt, & to
 detain until you shall find good sureties or sureties as aforesaid, or until you or
 or you shall be delivered by the Lieutenant Governour or the Council of the said
 Maryland, or by greater part of you except the Lieutenant Governour for the time being
 to be out.

And we do hereby further grant unto you & every of you full power & authority
 to arrest or by your warrants to cause to be arrested and attached and to bring
 to due punishment all offenders & offenders in wrecks & misdeeds all for sale of
 markets regulators in grossers extortioners riotters & other offenders agt the
 peace within the said Province of Maryland.

And we do hereby command all the said Justice Consistors and Ministers of
 the peace that you & every of you be obedient unto you our said Commissioners and
 Commissioners & every of you in all things as aforesaid. Given under the great
 Seal of the said Province of Maryland at the Fort of St. Maries within the said
 Province on the fifth day of September anno Domini 1642.
