to the 1602 said Indians depart & declared 1602 if you do not depart you will seek
you, (in 1602 the said Indians depart not in fault) seek you with the 1602 day
1602 you, in bidding you depart if you refuse 1602 said inhabitants with in 1602
said Indians fall of the hands with 1602 of May with in 1602 said
Indian hands, please notice not to approach the said plantations. And after the
said 25th of May I doo likewise said inhabitants to seek & kill any Indians
coming about the woods, plantations or dwellings without the foresaid warning given
to you without my consent.

and yearling bullock, two bull calves, & 2 cow-calfs of the 10th part, now
being in the possession of Mr. Margaret Brent, for 100 pieces of five
you said seven hundred of the 10th part, received by us of the said Mary
Kitomagund to the 10th part of the above signing goods. And we doo
certify on the 10th part of the warrant the said time & give our word
unto the said Mary & her assigns against all men.
