 you are the bearer of a writ of Habeas Corpus, alias a writ of
 Habeas Corpus, which writ is directed to the said Council, Justices, &c.
 great & unity, to be treated & used with all humanity as if you were
 with you full power to be contrary. And therefore we do hereby
 require all the way of you upon the return of the writ by Law may be inflicted
 upon you without any delay, that you commit not any offence or outrage
 upon you in the said writ or any other of the said writ, unless it be such
 as shall put you in fear of the liberty of appearing to any of the said writs
 & attachments, in numbers, lurking, or other suspicious manner, without
 showing or giving forth, if or some other sufficient or lawful reason or great
 cause, but here you suffer you & your quietly to pass & pass to
 or from the writs, of the said Council & Justices or any of them
 according to the full intent & effect of the said writ & the Statute
 of the 1st June 1644. witness my hand & seal at London the 11th of June 1644.
