On this first day of February 1600

It shall be lawful for the Governor, for this year only, to receive  
 and to assign the charge of it upon every year able to be carried away,  
 at any time before the first of December next, to be at such charge as  
 a barrell of round, or fifty pound of tobacco w<sup>th</sup> raff, at the charge of  
 crosses and buldies to be sent for, at the rate of twelve and twenty bar  
 hundred w<sup>th</sup> raff & twelve barrells of round, for a year's pay  
 payment of such buldies, in such quantities, & such places of the hundred, as  
 shall be appointed. And to appoint one or two places in every hundred, to which all  
 within the hundred, shall bring the round, or tobacco assigned upon them, before the  
 number next. And if any one regarded as aforesaid, shall not pay the same  
 according as shall be appointed by the Governor as aforesaid, the parties so  
 forfeit to the parties to whose payment he was charged, double the quantity of  
 tobacco or round so assigned, to be levied upon the parties offending, & way of  
 and the charge of the late Expedition to Kent, & of the assembly, & shall also  
 be to be defrayed out of the tobacco. ] Published under great Seal 13 Feb 1600
