George Ireland demandeth in name of ^{Security} ~~Edward~~ Regent of Edmond Southwell
300⁰ li. Tob. & cash due by him to be pay^d S^t. Feast day of Novemb^r. next.
Went to S^t. Henricke of S^t. Edmond put in security not to depart out of S^t.
Province, before S^t. debt be pay^d. or else to remain in safe custody.

June 17th

Capt. John Price, Capt. of S^t. Fort of S^t. Inegos, made S^t. Governour acquainted
of there was great want of powder in S^t. Fort, towards S^t. maintenance of
Soldiers. And desired S^t. Governour to take some speedy course to supply S^t.
want. And it was ordered by S^t. Governour that all such powder, as should be
any one's possessⁿ. wth in S^t. Province, should then for his own use, & his families
proper use, should be pay^d. at S^t. rates of 220⁰ li. barrell. being at
home, & common rate of 200⁰ li. in S^t. Province, upon his S^t. part, and for the
maintenance of S^t. Fort.
