Ruddan of Kenton 6 years servitude
went to the Sheriff to keepe of J^r Thomas in safe custody, until he shall put in
security to be at the Court some time before the first day of July next.

June 18th. This day came Henry Hooper Chirurgion & ^{acknowledged} himselfe to have rec^d
of Thomas Matthews, Attorney of Thomas Copley Esq^r. Three Coves & three
shells, in full satisfaction of all dues, debts, bills, suites, controversies w^{ch} were
from the beginning of the world unto this present day, betweene him & J^r Henry
Hooper, & J^r Thomas Copley afores^d.

Lijay, & Richard Willan his servants, specifying ^{his} my cloack suite to Rich: Willan
& my blacke suite to James Lijay. & my ^{his} warming linnen to be divided betweene
them. Also I give a mare Cole to my God-sonne Leo: Greene. Also hee
did desire of me his Executor that I give of my more Cole, to should fall
this year, (if it more fall wth in this year, then the first of shall hereafter fall)
unto M^r Temperance Ruppelt of Virginia. And further he deposed not.
