 one of copies can make you are their captives, that of when will you please to pay
 you for every other to please you will you shall receive full satisfaction, according to
 what justice will allow you. The matter you mention we regard not, being fully deter-
 mined (if any such things should be done) to give of disturbances of his majesty's Kings
 peace. These things must be done at any time when they shall invade us. And for your good
 therefore what will you please to pay us with you shall be none of them. The
 remainder of your money & law shall be fully provided for you & you need not doubt
 your money when it comes payable. The 140 comes length of Rowkes you
 may please to add to of claims above mentioned, wherein justice shall be duly
 committed unto you. I rest.

 The will being proved by testimonies afores^d of J^r Wil^m Tompson desires
 to be admitted to enter upon the estate of Rob^t Tutty, afores^d and laequall^{ly}
 & to have granted unto him l^{ies} of admistr^{on} grants of all the lands, debts,
 goods, & chattells, w^{ch} in this Province, belonging unto J^r Rob^t Tutty.
 Ordered by the Govern^{or} of J^r Wil^m Tompson, shall have l^{ies} of admistr^{on}
 of all the debts, lands, goods & chattells, belonging to Rob^t Tutty afores^d granted
 unto him forthwith.
