 you for any other to please you will you shall receive full satisfaction, according to
 what justice will be done. The matter you mention we regard not, being fully deter-
 mined (if any such things should be done) to give of disturbances of his majesty's Kings
 peace. These things must be done at any time when they shall need us. And for your good
 therefore what we have to say of content, we will you shall be none of them. The
 remainder of your money & law shall be fully provided for you & you need not doubt
 your money when it comes payable. The 140 comes length of Rowkes you
 may please to add to of claims above mentioned, wherein justice shall be duly
 committed unto you. I rest.

 2 men.

June 21st. William Tompson, exhibited a last will & testament of Rob^t. Tutty, & desires

 William Bretton saith upon oath, that he was present when Rob^t. Tutty made his
 last will & testament, & that he signed it with his own hand, & that the will exhibited by Wil^m. Tompson
 aforesaid is the right will.

Thomas Jackson being also present at the same time, deposed of the same.
 The will being proved by the testimonies aforesaid of the said Wil^m. Tompson desires
 to be admitted to enter upon the estate of Rob^t. Tutty, as executor, and to have
 & to have granted unto him the l^{ies} of admistr^{on} grants of all the lands, debts,
 goods, & chattells, within this Province, belonging unto the said Rob^t. Tutty.
 Ordered by the Govern^r of the said Wil^m. Tompson, shall have l^{ies} of admistr^{on}
 of all the debts, lands, goods, & chattells, belonging to Rob^t. Tutty aforesaid, granted
 unto him forthwith.
