

I doubt not yo^r are familiar to such unhappy passages as were of first inducement to me for the cessation of the government of Maryland. And although the species presence of a clause of absence in his Government's Commiss^t. was of whole pretended use of a diminution, I am confident it would not be held sufficient to discharge a general (even by his self) of his L^t government, then instated one more for those ensuing reasons.

first. The late Governor being out of the Province had not power to grant Commiss^t. for to rule them.

This self himself had then & immediate power, in election & choice of a Governor as of State of things then stood they supposed it absolutely necessary for the safety of the Province to continue more independent of any contradiction by his self and his by Assembly.

Gentlemen I presume upon this to make this position. & the government of the Province was inherent to me, till his self pleasure be further knownes, as his self right in self Province, or as yo^r his Commiss^t. What afforable losses both of fortunes & credit have hitherto, I doubt not, but report will bring it to yo^r. But in regard of friends & the wrongs of slaves, I have beene ruined by giving breath of the Composite extremely clamorous in my ears, for I was assured, if not credit, or loss, will give me, I scarce, to some strange, ouverture in self business. I am altogether unwilling to name & staine, what a mandation, loss, & ruin, it will produce, self whole, I am not ignorant of, that either some moderate way were taken, for satisfaction on all sides. I mention by the death of the late General (gentleman) as now but all discontent may be easily pacified & brought to good terms of quietuation since my breath a spirit posses^t unto them, & every one there, resolute. But if self me once breake out, it is to be feared^t of proceeding from such an influence of discontent, it may overwhelm me wholly. So on this there is only difference in the power of the Governor, not his self title infringed, nor self peace, & self yo^r may be confident, it may be acted w^t out end, or self punishment thereof. we will happily fall on self losers. Now soend (me. S^r Will^t Berkeley) us, as my master can procure a private right but by attorney, I have little hope to provide on this busines of such concern^t, yet & I might give a formal demurrer w^t self & want of all proceedings, I have adventure to be wroght thus much unto us myself, but most frankly, one request you were I would be for alteration of your self & safety of the Province under his self. It is faire, for all self know self may be done worthy. for others of him^t differ ent from myself, power
