Attorney and ordaine my trusty and well beloved John Hollis of the province of Maryland my true and lawfull attorney, to aske sue for and recover, recover and receive all and sundry such debts, salaries, and what so ever is due unto the sd Capt Edward Hill here in the province of Maryland by or from any person or persons now resident in the sd Province, as witness my hand this 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1646: Edw: Hill
