Charles Maynard aged 25 yeeres or thereabouts att^d of request of W^m Lewis
sayth upon his oath that being att M^r Gervards house, Capt. Hen: Hleak & M^r
Payne was there & bought hoggs of M^r Gervard, & amongst other hoggs the J^r
M^r Gervard sold to J^r Lewis above J^r 2 hoggs viz one Boare, & one sow,
of a yeare old & better, wth J^r M^r Gervard told this Dep^t that they were M^r
Lewis hoggs, & further added if hee would kill, & sell them, the better to sa-
tisfy a debt, wth J^r M^r Lewis, owed to J^r M^r Gervard. And this Dep^t
further sayth of to J^r best of his remembrance, all the great work, ready
framed, or fitted, was fetched away by J^r M^r Gervard's appointment of J^r
M^r Gervard, from of M^r Lewis land, & applyed to his owne proper use
of J^r M^r Gervard. Likewise this Dep^t sayth that there was a chest of J^r
M^r Lewis in M^r Gervards house, wth this Dep^t demanded of the J^r M^r Gervard
whereupon J^r M^r Gervard replyed if hee could not spare it, for he intended
