

Notwithstanding all past considerations to any persons then inhabiting this Province whatsoever to require all persons who have since the 24th of March last past to this day or shall hereafter come into this Province here to inhabit to take notice of these his last conditions & declaration aforesaid, as the only titles by which they can lay any lands here & punctually to performe them as they expect to have Grants of any the lands so by them claimed within this his Lordships Province of Maryland And in Particular that hereafter there shall be no land granted to or for or in respect of any person or persons whatsoever who shall not within one month next after his or their arrivall into this Province make demaund of the land so due to them & take the oath of Fidelity to the Lord Proprietary with such alteration in itt as is mentioned in the report made by the Committee for Trade to his Highnes the Lord Protector bearing date 16 of September 1656 and legally pursue the suing out of their Grants or Patents within the time in the said Conditions Prescribed as aforesaid. Given at S^t Marys 13th of April in 26th year of his Lordships Dominion over this Province of Maryland Annoq^{ue} Domini 1658.

The Governor and Councell took into Consideration the small number of his Lordships present counsell of state, & weighing the abilities, & aptitude service done by Mr Baker Brookes & Mr Nathaniel Drie in this last assembly. Called them to the bar, and according to his Lordships instructions of 2^o of November 1654 the Govern^{or} with the approbacion of Philip Calvert Esq^r nominated and appointed them to be of his last Councell of state for this Province, who after disabling themselves, took the oath and sate as Councillors.
