And all persons whatsoever are hereby strictly and required to yeald all due obedience to you the said Captaine Drans in all things appertaining to the Command & office hereby conferred on you as they will answer the contrary at theyr perill Given under my hand & seale this 15th day of June in the 26th year of his Majesty's dominion over this Province Annoq^{ue} Domini 1658.

According to the power to me by his said Lordship committed & upon the speciall trust & confidence I have in your fidelity circumspection courage & good conduct I doe hereby constitute ordaine & appoint you Lieutenant under Captaine William Drans of the foot company by him to be raised betwene Wicocomaco River & Poplar hill exclusively, them to Muster Exercise & traine upon the Art of Warre & discipline military & in all things to do as any Lieutenant of a Company of foot may or of right ought to do to the resistance of all enimys suppression of all mutings insoleny & rebellions whatsoever according to such orders and directions as you shall from time to time receive from me or your said Captaine. To have & to hold the said office & Command till the Lord Proprietary or his heirs or he or theyr Lieutenant cheife Governour or Captaine Generall for the time being shall signify his or theyr pleasure to the contrary. And all persons whatsoever are hereby required & strictly commanded to yeald all due obedience to you the said Lieutenant Sarbo in all things appertaining to the Command and office hereby conferred on you as they will answer the contrary at theyr perills.
