The Councell take into debate the settlement of the Court for the County of Annapundell & the defects in the former Commission. And ordered That William Burges Thomas Meares Robert Burle Thomas Solde Roger Grose Thomas Howell Richard Wells, Richard Ewen John Brewer Anthony Salway & Richard Woolman Gent should be Com^s for the said County & that they should by the Sherriff be summoned to appear on 22th Instant at the house of Mr Edward Royd to take the oath of Commissioners & Justices of the Peace. and that the 23th Instant should be the first court day. Warrant issued upon this Order to John Rowwood Sherriff to summon the said Persons & give notice of the Court.

Then was taken into Consideration the further settlement of militia and Resolved that for the Present the forces of the Province should be divided into two Regiments the one consisting of all the forces in Patowmack & Patuxent River the other of all the forces from the Coves up to the seven mountaines, and the Isle of Kent. The first of w^{ch} the Governour would command himselfe the other should be commanded by Mr Nathaniell Vlie. &
Ordered

- Colonell Nathaniell Vlie That a Commission be drawne for Col^l Nathaniell Vlie to command all the forces betweene the Coves of Patuxent River & the seven mountaines, & that he command at his owne Company all the forces from the head of Seaverne River on the northside thereof to the seven Mountaines.
- Cap: Lt Jo: Cumber That a Commission be drawne for John Cumber to be his Captaine Lieutenant. And that they chuse theyr ensigne.
- Maio: Ri: Ewens That a Commission be drawne for Richard Ewen to command as Maio: vnder Col^l: Nathaniell Vlie, & that he command at his owne Company all the forces from the Southside of South River up to the head thereof and Mr Anthony Salways house in the Herwing Creeke inclusively.
- Lt Alex: Gourdon That a Commission be drawne for Alexander Gourdon to be his Lieutenant: that they chuse theyr ensigne.
- Cap: Tho: Howell That a Commission be drawne to Captaine Thomas Howell to command all the forces on the southside of Seaverne River up to the head thereof & the north side of South River up to the head thereof.
- Lt John Collier That a Commission be drawne for John Collier to be his Lieutenant. That they chuse theyr ensigne.
- Cap: Tho: Bradrooke That a Commission be drawne for Thomas Bradrooke to command all the forces on the Isle of Kent.
- Lt Tho: Netherell That Thomas Netherell be his Lieutenant. that they chuse theyr ensigne.
