

what former writs are belonging and incident to
 one of our Councill of State and Conservato^r and
 Justice of peace there in as full and ample manner
 as any other of our Councill there may lawfully
 to have and Enjoy as a Councillor Conservator or
 Justice of the peace in our said Province. Verily
 willing and requiring our said Lieutenant and the
 rest of our Councill of the said Province of Maryland
 to admit and receive him the said Henry Sewall as
 one of our Councill of State Conservato^r and Justice
 of peace in our said Province as aforesaid and provided
 always that he take in open Court in our said
 Province the oath of a Councillor of State appointed
 by us to be taken by those of our Councill there
 before he sitt or Acte as one Councill of State and
 Conservato^r or Justice of peace in our said province
 to be administered unto him by our said Lieutenant
 or any two of our Councill there to him and lawfully
 respectively empowered and required to administer
 the same accordingly. And we do by this
 present revoke all former Com^{ms} at any time
 heretofore granted by us to any other person or
 persons for the place or office of our Principall
 Secretary of our said Province and of the
 powers and office hereunder mentioned. And we
 have by statute appointed and ordered him the
 said Henry Sewall to be our Principall Secretary
 of our said Province of Maryland and to have
 all full privileges and benefitts as belonging
 to our principall Secretary there. And we
 do by this present appointe constitute and ordaine
 the said Henry Sewall to be our principall officer
 and keeper of the Acts and proceedings of us.
